Having money is not bad, but serving money instead of God is. We should make the choice to serve God with our money and be smart with the blessings He gives. But how do we do this?

God wants us to learn that He blesses us and takes care of all of our needs. He wants us to be obedient to His Word by bringing our tithe to the storehouse, which is the church.

God is asking for your best today and every day. Since everything we have comes (in one way or another) from our Heavenly Father, giving our tithes is really just giving 10% back to Him.

When we are generous, it means that we are willing to give or share with others. It is an unselfish act that comes from a caring heart. Generosity is more than giving gifts and money.

Generosity starts in our heart. Think about what God's already given to you and be grateful for it. Once you recognize all that you have, look for ways to share it with others.

Keep track of the numerous ways you see generosity in your day-to-day life.

Something like:

- Spendling time with a friend

Honoring God with our money by how we save it is so important! It can be easy to say "I need it" about something when we really should be saying "I want it."

Knowing what we "need" versus what we "want" helps us to prioritize the things we ask for or purchase with our own money. Hebrews chapter 13 tells us to "be happy with what you have."

DO I *NEED* IT? VS DO I *WANT* IT?

By being happy (or content), it keeps us from spending our money on things that we don't need or that don't matter. When we save, we are able to make wise choices and have more money for other things later. Saving teaches us wise stewardship.

Honoring God with our money by how we spend it is so important! Making wise choices means we are being a good steward of what God has given us.

A good steward is someone who takes care of another person's things. They are responsible for it and they are stewards because God has called them to take care of the things He has given them. By being a good steward of God's blessings in our lives, we are showing God that we are grateful and that we can be trusted.

A GOOD STEWARD IS SOMEONE WHO TAKES CARE OF ANOTHER PERSON'S THINGS

Need wisdom in knowing how to spend money? God places wise people in our lives – parents, teachers, leaders – to help guide and give wise counsel. God's Word, the Bible, talks a lot about money and gives instruction on how to give, spend, and save.
